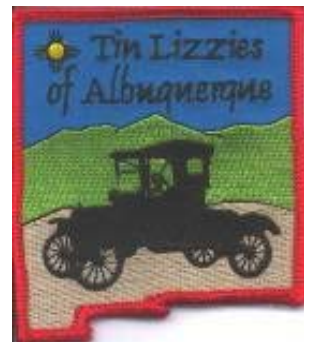

A reminder about your T: Check your oil and water each time before driving. Remember that the cooling system on a T is not pressurized so coolant can, and does, evaporate out of the system and needs to be replaced often. This is especially true in warm weather. Your oil level should be kept so that the oil just drizzles out of the top petcock in the pan. Also, check your stop light(s)!

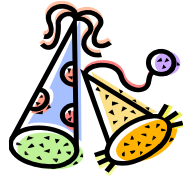

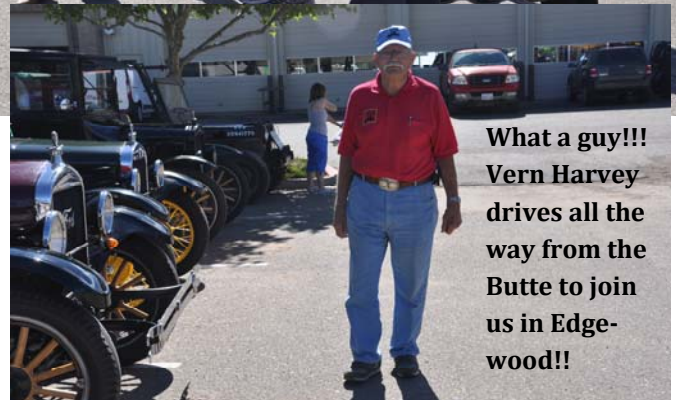
