





The October meeting was held at the Vineyard, 6118 Edith, NE in Albuquerque. The meeting was called to order by president Mark Dominguez who led us in the Pledge of Allegiance. We were glad to have Jo Ann Armstrong back after her recent illness.

The minutes were approved as published.

Marilyn Duncan, treasurer, gave the treasurer's report. Expense of 60.96 for cups and plates and income of \$73.00 for the raffle and a a \$125 donation from the Encino Vista Nursing home for a total of \$222.00 was reported.

Committee reports were given. Dave Merewether reported for the NM Council of Car Clubs. The monthly meeting has not been held for October since their meeting will be a week later due to the 4th Wednesday meeting date that will be next week. The council Newsletter acknowledged the participation of the Tin Lizzies with volunteers for the Swap Meet. Please let Linda Riel know if you wish to be notified of club events by telephone. Monday is the deadline for Robbie Ross to receive material for the Newsletter. Kirk Peterson is again sending out the e-mails. Mark Dominguez had assisted for a time after the death of Kirk's father. Thanks Mark and welcome back Kirk. Mark Wing does a wonderful job of keeping the website current by posting news and pictures of club events and networking to other items of interest. He requests help to share some of the responsibilities for keeping the site updated. He reported that visits to the site were 935 for the last 30 days. The site has been updated with pictures from the Balloon Fiesta, the Range Cafe Breakfast, a work day and information on the 2016 Tour. Bernice sent cards to Laura Kammerer to wish her a speedy recovery and to Kirk and Susan Peterson. Members were encouraged to send cards to Laura and to Kirk and Susan. Items are available for checkout from the Librarian and can be picked up either at his home, his office, or one of the Tin Lizzie events. Marilyn Duncan said there was nothing new for the historian, but she passed out business cards for the Tin Lizzies for those who wanted them. In the absence of Larry Azevedo, it was reported that all parts are in stock for the Quartermaster. The raffle items this month included an L4 Kingston intake manifold/ carbuerator and brackets for a 1919 running board, donated by John Hayne.

Meeting refreshments were provided by Sharon and Mark Dominguez, Vern Harvey, and Linda Riel.

Dave Merewether reported that the Swap Meet hosted by the NM Car Council sold more spaces than ever before. Since many more of the participants registered early under their educed fee schedule, income from the event was about the same as in past years.

Several Model T's were displayed at the Corrales Harvest Festival. Many thanks to all those who brought their cars and to those that helped the Azevedo's get all their cars to the display.

There were 8 or 9 cars displayed at the Balloon Fiesta on October 4, reported Betty Householder. The weather was beautiful and 2 balloons landed just in front of the Model Ts.

The October 10 T 'n Vittles hosted by Neill and Mary Ann O'Brien had 3 cars and 26 people at the Range Cafe.

The November T 'n Vittles breakfast will be on the 14 of November at the K and I Diner, 2500 Broadway, SE. The breakfast will be hosted by Stan and Janice Gauna at 8:00 am.

Nominees are still being accepted for officers of the Lizzies for 2016. Anyone willing to serve in an officer or director position should give their name to the nominating committee. Elections will be held at the November meeting.

The Corralles Christmas Parade and Holiday Dinner is scheduled for December 5. Members in cars for the parade can meet at the Azevedo residence, then proceed to the parade route.

Bernice reports that the pueblo Tribal Police will be available to assist members with parking. Other activities will be a native house for participants to tour, a Native American meal will be served, photos will be allowed with the permission of people being photographed, and Tribal Dancers will perform.

The November meeting will be held a week early to avoid conflict with Thanksgiving. This will be our annual "guys with pies" refreshment night.

Dues for 2016 will be accepted at any time. Please avoid the rush that often occurs at our January meeting.

Members were reminded to vote for Russel Dilts to be a member of the National Board of Directors.

Members had toured the Tierra Wools facility during our Chama Tour and some had expressed a desire to participate in a weaving school. Brochures were available with details on Tierra Wool's upcoming weaving school for those interested.

For sale vehicles include Linda Riel's Lula Belle, the Ross's fire truck, and the 1927 Roadster Pickup belonging to Brian Dean's brother-in-law (price reduced to \$7500.00).

Mark Wing and Dave Ferro were winners of the raffle prizes.

The meeting was adjourned.


