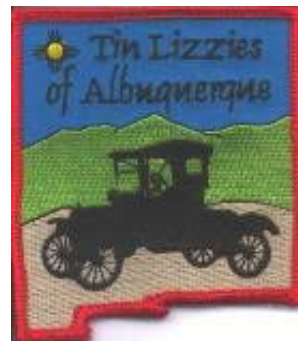

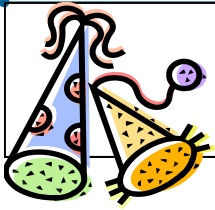
Roadrunner Food Bank Donation Month!!

Los Alamos County Fair Weekend August 8-11 by Skip Dunn

Skip & Hedy Dunn are sponsoring a Tin Lizzie Tour/Los Alamos County Fair Weekend Aug 8-11.

Here are a few highlights of the tour:

Tour Hotel-Comfort Inn, 2455 Trinity Drive, 505-661-1110. We have a special group rate of \$72 per night. Ask for the Tin Lizzies rate when you call.

Thurs, Aug 8...Check in at the hotel, & meet at 600PM at the Dixie Girl Restaurant, 1789 Central Ave for registration, followed by 630PM dinner & camaraderie. It is within a block of most downtown motels.

After dinner, join the group in the meeting room at the Comfort Inn for a viewing of Genevieve, the 1953 movie about the London to Brighton Run of pre-1904 cars,

Fri, Aug 9...900AM...Tour the back roads to the **Santa Fe Opera**, with stops at the **Otowi Bridge at Rio Grande**, the **San Ildefonso Pueblo**, & **Camel Rock**. At the Opera we will enjoy a behind-the-scenes tour, including their custom-made Model T 7-door stretch touring car. Lunch at the cantina is available.

We retrace our steps to the **Tesuque Market** & stop for refreshments & head back to Los Alamos.

We travel the truck Rt. back to Los Alamos. We plan to attend the "**Gordon's (country music) Concerts**" an outdoor music, food, & fun event at Ashley Pond from 7 -10PM. Vendors will be there or choose from the list of restaurants that will be provided.

Sat, Aug 10...900AM...We will line up for the **County Fair Parade** starting at **10AM**. From **12PM-5PM** there will be the Rodeo, Exhibits, Bazaar.

Sun, Aug 11...900AM...Trip to **White Rock Overlook Park** for a spectacular view of the White Rock Canyon. Our next stop is at **Jim Stine's Old Texaco Station & Soda Bar**. We will then travel to **Bandelier National Monument, Circle Tour**, 30 miles. We will have a picnic lunch or luncheon counter in the park. Depart **130PM** for 45 min trip back to Los Alamos. (left foot about 1 mile.)

You need about \$20 for admission to Bandelier & the Pueblo. You still have time to sign up for this great tour!
