



TIN LIZZIES CLUB MEETING January 22, 2015

The January meeting was called to order by our new president, Mark Dominguez who led us in the Pledge of Allegiance. Pam Prater, daughter of David and Ann Merewether, was a guest at our meeting.

The minutes were approved as published.

Marilyn Duncan, treasurer, gave the treasurer's report and presented the budget for the year. Projected receipts will be slightly more than our anticipated expenditures. There should be a decrease in the cost of printing the newsletter as Robbi Ross, newsletter editor, will do the printing at her cost for paper and ink.

Committee reports were given. Dave Merewether reported that the NM Car Council has not met since November. The January meeting will be as regularly scheduled on the fourth Wednesday which will be January 28. Robbi Ross said that the deadline for submission of information for the Newsletter would be Sunday, January 25. Mark Wing reported that the website had been updated with information on the Holiday Parade and dinner, Mimi's T 'n Vittles, and 2 work parties. Visitors to the site fell to 538. Club videos have been removed from the site and replaced with links listed to view them on You Tube. Hospitality chairman reported no cards were sent out the last month. Mark Dominguez reported that several items were checked out of the library at the last Board Meeting. Quartermaster Larry Azevedo reported that all parts for the inventory are in stock. Historian Marilyn Duncan reported that the DVD of the 35 years of the Tin Lizzies presented at the December dinner meeting was well received. She also reported that in 2013 the club established the parts inventory for the quartermaster with an expenditure of \$1,000.00. Linda Riel asked members to sign up for future T 'n Vittles and meeting refreshments.

Tin Lizzie members brought 12 cars to the Corrales Holiday Parade and 55 people attended the dinner at the Azevedo residence. There were 3 cars and about 30 members at the January T 'n Vittles at Mimi's Cafe hosted by Mark and Susan Wing. Title to the Telephone truck from the now defunct Telephone Pioneers of New Mexico Museum is still in the process of being transferred. Insurance will have to be obtained for the trailer and truck.

Larry Azevedo has been elected to the board of our National Club. He reports that only 52% of our members are members of the national organization. Fifty percent is required for our events to be covered with liability insurance. He encourages all members to become members of the national group and receive their outstanding publication, *The Vintage Ford*. One idea to increase national membership is to give a one year membership in the Tin Lizzies to new members who join the national.

Linda Riel reported that Bob and Robbi Ross will host our February T 'n Vittles at Wecks, 1105 Juan Tabo, NE and also provide refreshments for our February meeting.

Linda Riel reminded us of Rich Ford's 54th anniversary celebration for which the Model T members are requested to bring their cars for display on March 7th. A 1915 car is desired for their showroom display. Let Linda know by March 1 if you can attend.

Larry plans a work day for Saturday January 24. An "Ethan" work day will be on January 27 when all work will be dedicated to Ethan's car.

The Great Race from Missouri to California will be passing through in June when they will be overnighting on June 23 at Santa Fe. They will be in Albuquerque on June 24 and we hope to arrange something with our cars to welcome them.

Larry Azevedo is working on a spring tour to Silver City in May and we are thinking Chama would be a good fall tour. Vaughn is arranging State Fair Participation.

The raffle was held, after which Marilyn Duncan presented the program on interesting information she had found during her work as historian. She highlighted the beginning of work days when it was started by Tom Miles and called "garage days". The meeting was adjourned.
