

TIN LIZZIES CLUB MINUTES JANUARY 28, 2016

The first meeting of 2016 for the Tin Lizzies was held January 28, 2016 at the Vineyard, 6118 Edith, NE in Albuquerque. The meeting was called to order by president Mark Dominguez who led us in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Visitor Dilbert Glover, brother-in-law of Brian Dean was welcomed. We congratulate Joe Fellen and welcome him as a new member. Les Haley, a member from Amarillo, Texas, was visiting.

The minutes were approved as published. Ann Merewether, secretary, read correspondence from The Model T Ford Club of America. They thanked our group for our \$500.00 donation to the National Model T Museum and for our \$150.00 donation to the national organization in memory of three of our members who passed during 2015. A Christmas Card from Laura Kammerer and David Ferro was read that thanked the members for their support during Laura's illness. She still would appreciate your support.

Marilyn Duncan gave the Treasurer's report. She presented a budget for 2016 which anticipates \$2,800.00 in income for 2016 and \$2,800.00 in expenses. After discussion, Larry Azevedo moved that we accept the budget. Bob Ross seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Committee reports were given. Dave Merewether reported that the NM Car Council met on January 27. Their annual car show on May 15 will have a Route 66 theme and will feature cars from the 1930's and 1940's. They request that our club have a Model T on display that has a sign "California or Bust" and other items relevant to that time. The all clubs picnic is scheduled for August 14 at Oak Flats Picnic Area. The Swap meet will be held Sept 23, 24, and 25. Cost will increase to \$30.00 this year with 500 spaces available.

Robbi Ross reports that she will be in Denver, Colorado for the next 3 months and will need all pictures and information for the newsletter be submitted to her via e-mail. She will continue to prepare the newsletter and Bob will print and mail here in Albuquerque. The the deadline for submission of information for the next Newsletter would be by Sunday, January 31.

Mark Wing reported that there were 869 unique visitors to our website during the last 30 days. The website has been updated with the Holiday parade and party, 3 work days, and breakfast at Mick's Chili Fix. He has also added more selectable tabs. Kirk Peterson will assist Mark by doing all calendar updates in Robbi's absence. More assistance for the website is needed. Volunteers, anyone?

January birthdays of our members were announced and wished a Happy Birthday.

Bernice Young sent 9 cards to members in the last period. Quartermaster Larry Azevedo reports that all supplies and parts are in stock. He does have a right rear fender for a 1917 thru 1924 T as surplus. This fender was provided by our Amarillo member, Les Haley.

Historian Marilyn Duncan reports that several more boxes of historical documents have been turned over to her and she is getting those items placed in books.

Rich Ford has announced that their 55th anniversary celebration will be March 5th. We need to have a car count and trailer count at our February meeting. Linda Riel will be spearheading this show of Model Ts at the dealership.

All other committee members reported no changes.

Items for the raffle were shown and members given an opportunity to purchase tickets to win one of the three prizes—GMC car framed picture, nuts with a bag, and automobile cleaning products.

Refreshments for the meeting were provided by Mark and Sharon Dominguez and Vaughn Rockefeller. President Mark Dominguez welcomed the new officers for 2016. In addition to Mark, Vaughn Rockefeller is VP, Secretary is Ann Merewether, Treasurer is Marilyn Duncan and Board of Directors is Tom Miles, Donna Hansen, and Paul Duncan. President Dominguez thanked Sharon Dominguez and her volunteers for the enjoyable Holiday Party and Larry and Lorna Azevedo for hosting the event.

Betty Householder was congratulated for receiving the President's Award for 2015.

Bob and Robbi Ross hosted our last breakfast at Mick's Chili Fix on January 9. The cold weather discouraged everyone from driving their T car, so we had 0 cars and 27 people in attendance.

Work days at Larry's garage continue to be productive with car restoration progress. A major project in process is the rebuilding of a motor for Les Haley.

Mark reported that the new board had met at his home and he plans to conduct quarterly board meetings. Each of our Board directors will arrange 3 programs for our monthly meetings, each lasting 3 to 4 ½ minutes. Members were asked to consider the possibility of a fall tour to be planned and held after our National Tour is completed.

The 2016 tour planning is progressing at the monthly meeting held just prior to the regular T meeting. A firm budget for the registration costs for each entrant is \$240 for the car owner and \$190 for an additional person. We now have 84 cars and 191 people registered for the tour. A registration fee of \$100.00 has been established for volunteers who assist with the tour but do not drive. This cost covers the activities and meals for the tour. The New Mexico Ford Dealers Association is a sponsor for the tour.

Jessica Lance was appointed to do the annual audit of our financial books.

The next T 'n Vittles will be at the Mule Barn located at 9700 2nd Street, NW at 8:00 am. There are new owners of the restaurant who have initiated a "No Smoking" policy.

Larry Azevedo recently attended the Model T Ford Club of America meeting as a board member. He announced that our Russel Dilts did not get elected to the board in the last election. See your new Vintage Ford for a list of the new Directors.

After the refreshment break, the raffle was held for this meeting's prizes.

Dan and Holly Rochford will provide refreshments for our next meeting.
