TIN LIZZIES CLUB MEETING MINUTES May 26, 2016

Mark Dominguez called the May meeting of the Tin Lizzies to order and led us in the Pledge of Allegiance. He welcomed Tom MacGugan from Las Cruces to the meeting.

The April minutes were approved as published in the April Newsletter Ann Merewether reported no correspondence during the month.

Treasurer Marilyn Duncan gave the Treasurer's report. She reported expenses of \$177.80 and income of \$245.50. The \$200.00 donation included in that amount had been previously included in the April report.

Dave Merewether gave the NM Car Council report. The May 11 meeting had been devoted to filling the goodie bags for entrants in the May 15 car show at the Albuquerque Museum. The car show on the 15 was a nice show with mostly Resto Rods. Jim Glover did win an award, and Kirk Peterson, Dave Merewether and Paul Beck also displayed cars.

Kirk Peterson is sending out e-mails as requested and had a telephone number for new members Scott and Alicia Stewart for Linda Riel's calling list.

Robbi Ross needs materials for the Newsletter by 7:00 Monday evening, May 30.

There were 941 unique visitors to the Tin Lizzie website during the last month. Mark has posted pictures and articles of the Power Ford show, the Weck's breakfast and another work day at the Azevedo home.

Bernice Young reports all members are well and no cards were sent in the last month.

Mark Dominguez reports that he still needs to add a video to the library. All materials may be checked out. Historian Marilyn Duncan has given video film to Tom Miles that he will convert to digital.

Robbie and Bob Ross and Marilyn and Paul Duncan provided cookies and milk for our meeting refreshments. Thank you for the delicious treat.

Mark Wing, Paul and Marilyn Duncan, Don Mitchell, Betty and Mike Housholder, and Mark Dominguez displayed cars for the Power Ford Car Show.

A jewel in the club activities is the work days hosted by Larry Acevedo at his garage. Recent work included the rear end rebuild of Kirk Peterson's car and major rework on the car of Ken Carpenter to make it navigable.

Six Model T cars and several modern cars made the tour to Madrid for lunch after a stop at the Mark and Susan Wing home for breakfast. Bruce Daniel's car with Vern Armstrong driving (and mechanicing) had to have the carburetor rebuilt. The fiber timing gear failed on Dave Merewether's center door on the way home. Despite a frantic call to Larry Azevedo in California for help, the car could not be field repaired and it was trailered back to Albuquerque. The club voted that both Dave Merewether and Ken Carpenter should be awarded a "Little Peep" for their car problems.

The T 'n Vittles breakfast on May 14 was hosted by Phillip and Jessica Lance at Weck's restaurant with 6 cars on display and 28 people enjoying breakfast together. The following day, Zach Lance participated in a fundraiser for St. Baldrick's Children Cancer. This event resulted in \$15,000.00 being raised for cancer research.

Linda Riel will now store the paper goods used by the club for meeting refreshments, formerly done by Vaughn Rockefeller.

Marilyn Duncan had copies of the new club brochure with artwork by Mark Wing. These will be used by members to promote our club.

Discussion was opened on the proposed Bylaws revision for Life Membership that was presented at the April meeting. It was determined that there were 40 voting members in attendance, with 15 required for a quorum. No motion was required because the proposed revision was presented by the Board. The pros and cons were discussed, with Don Mitchell suggesting an additional clarification to the amendment. A vote was taken on the proposed amendment and it passed by a vote of 31 to 1. A vote was then taken on the proposed

amendment to the amendment which passed by a 30 to 1 count. The revised Bylaw for Life Membership is as follows:

"Article III Members

Section 2. Life Members

a. Members who are Founding Members of the Tin Lizzies of Albuquerque and who have paid \$120.00 dues to the general Club treasury will no longer pay annual dues. Spouse may become a Life Member and pays no annual dues.

b. Members in good standing for four years of continuous membership who have paid a one time payment of \$150.00 to the general Club treasury will no longer pay annual dues. Spouse may become a Life Member and pays no annual dues.

c. Members in good standing for four years of continuous membership who have reached the age of 80 years by December 31st become Life Members on January 1st of the next calendar year and will no longer pay annual dues. Spouse may become a Life Member and pays no annual dues.

Section 4. (Entirely deleted)"

Betty Housholder will host the June 4th breakfast at the Vineyard. Breakfast will cost \$4.00. Club members will provide rides for the residents of the park as a thank you for allowing our club to meet there each month. At 10:30 Larry Azevedo will conduct committee meetings in preparation for the National Tour.

St. Theresa's Healthcare and Rehabilitation Center at 7900 Constitution Ave NE will make a club donation in return for cars placed on display between the hours of 10:00 am and 12:00 noon.

Our Model T cars are optional to display at the Celebration of Life for Laura Kammerer. This will be held June 11th at 5:30 pm at the Coronado Historic Site in Bernalillo.

Linda Riel announced that Rich Ford has requested that we display our cars at their Edgewood dealership on August 13. It was noted that this date is the date previously announced for our cars to be displayed at the National Nuclear Museum with the airplanes. Efforts are being made to reschedule one of the events to a different date.

Our club received a credit from Vista Print when we ordered the magnetic door signs for the tour. This credit is being offset by orders for discounts for merchandise orders by members. Samples of shirts and hats were on display for members to check sizes and colors before placing orders.

Plaques were displayed that will be presented as a thank you to Mr. Schneider of Rich Ford at the National Tour banquet. We appreciate the wonderful support that he has given us over the years. Also a "Thank You" to Vern Willam for the beautiful walnut bases for the plaques.

Committee meetings to work on plans for the National Tour were held in lieu of our usual program. More volunteers were solicited for Tour events.

Raffle winners were Danielle Lance, Kirk Peterson, and Bernice Young.

Refreshments for our June meeting will be provided by Gerald Hash and Jahn and Barbara Wright. The meeting was adjourned.




