



TIN LIZZIES CLUB MEETING MINUTES August 25, 2016

Mark Dominguez, President, called the August meeting of the Tin Lizzies to order. The attendees then stood and repeated the Pledge of Allegiance. Members were welcomed.

Since this was our ice cream social refreshment night, we enjoyed refreshments before the business meeting. We had 5 flavors of ice cream with numerous toppings. Thanks to everyone who contributed to our refreshments.

Guests for the evening were Frank (owns a black roadster) and Frank (owns a 1926 Touring, a 24 Tudor, a speedster and a 1926 Runabout. Both are former members of the Tin Lizzies and plan to renew membership.

The minutes of the last meeting were approved as published. The club received no correspondence this month. Vice President Vaughn Rockefeller showed raffle items for this evening's drawing.

Marilyn Duncan reported donations to the club in the amount of \$100.00 from the Buena Vista Senior Care and \$500.00 from Rich Ford. Marilyn also received \$12.00 in dues, \$58.00 from the raffle, and \$60.00 in sale of door magnets. She still has magnets available in both brass and silver for \$5.00 each.

Committee reports were as follows:

Dave Merewether gave the NM Car Council report. The August meeting was on Wednesday evening. The all clubs picnic at Oak Flats on August 14 was a big success, but they were disappointed at the large number of non-car club members who were there for the free food. The Swap Meet to be held September 23, 24 and 25 in Las Lunas now has a paved field with 311 spaces. Volunteers are needed to work the Swap Meet. Contact Joyce at NMCC to volunteer.

Kirk Peterson always keeps members up to date with his e-mails and Mark Dominguez keeps the library ready for materials to be checked out. Hospitality reported that cards were sent to Clarence Schritter and Vern Harvey. Bernice will not be able to continue as Hospitality chairman and a new one needs to be named. Clarence is home recovering from a heart attack and Vern was well enough to be with us for the meeting. Robbi needs information for the Newsletter no later than Sunday evening. Historian Marilyn Duncan reports no news as Historian. Linda Riel reminded members to let her know if they wish to be notified of meetings via phone.

The T 'n Vittles breakfast on August 13 was hosted by Dave and Ann Merewether at the Owl Cafe. Following breakfast, the members drove to the National Nuclear Museum for a display with the airplanes. There were 16 cars present and about 32 members. The Museum reported that museum attendance was increased by the presence of the Model T s.

Mark Wing reported that he has added 4 events to our website. These are the Senior Car exhibit, the Owl Cafe Breakfast, the National Nuclear Museum display, and Rich Ford. There were 957 unique visitors to the web site in the last 30 days.

Quartermaster Larry Azevedo reports all parts and supplies are in stock. The new items that were added have arrived from Langs with the exception of a few back-ordered parts.

On August 14 our cars were displayed at Rich Ford in Edgewood. Linda Riel organized this event and we had 11 cars on display. Paul and Marilyn Duncan received a "little peep" to commerate a dead battery on their T. Consequently we had one modern car in attendance, and Rich Ford was able to sell a 2017 car to Janice Gauna. Art Gebo from Grants showed off his new 1922 Speedster.

Seven cars were brought to the Buena Vista Senior Care facility on August 6. The facility is located at 8505 Rancho Santa Fe Place NE. Larry, Stan, Don Mitchell, Paul, Kirt, Mark Wing and Mark Dominguez brought their cars.

Phil Lance has a 1925 Model T Runabout that will be showing up at our work days soon and Linda Riel has sold her Lula Bell.

The final report on the Land of Enchantment Tour final report was given by Larry Azevedo and Sharon Dominguez. Excess registration costs amounted to \$14,463.66 over expenses. The club is allowed to keep a portion, and the remainder will be refunded to participants. Registered drivers will be refunded \$64.30 each, passenger will be refunded 50.91, and each child/volunteer will be refunded \$26.79. The motion was made, seconded and carried that the members accept the financial report. Larry Azevedo reported that the delivery of the recovered stolen speedster was delivered home to its owner when he went to California to see his mother. The motion was made and seconded that the club reimburse Larry \$200.00 for his extra gas expense incurred in the delivery. After discussion, motion carried.

Larry Azevedo will host a work party on August 27th at 9:00. Bring a lunch and he will supply root beer floats for desert.

The September T 'n Vittles will be hosted by Vernon and Jo Ann Armstrong at Heniretta's, 740 Main St, Los Lunas at 9:00.

The State Fair exhibit organized by Vaughn Rockefeller will be on September 11. Plans are to meet at the SW corner of Central and San Pedro at 7:30 am. We will caravan to the fairgrounds at 7:50 am to park in the same place that we always park. The Fair plans a special 9/11 memorial service on our display street at noon. Bob Ross volunteered to drive the telephone truck.

Betty Householder is organizing a display of our cars at the Albuquerque International Balloon Fiesta on October 2. Let her know if you will be able to attend so that she can arrange for passes for our cars.

The Corrales light parade will be held December 3, 2016. Snacks will be served at the Azevedo residence after the parade.

Tom Miles complemented those responsible for the design of our new Tin Lizzie flyer.

Donna Hansen presented the program for the evening on Garage Humor. The program was cute and well received. Donna just needs a better moustache.

Raffle winners were Bob Ross, Bruce Daniel, and Michael Householder.

The September meeting refreshments will be provided by Don Mitchell, Neil and Mary Ann O'Brien and Janice and Stan Gauna.
