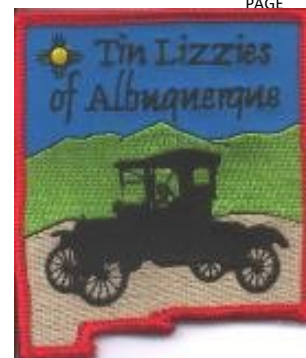

Nov 17 [Tin Lizzie Meeting. GUYS WITH PIES. Also this is election night. Must be present to vote](#)

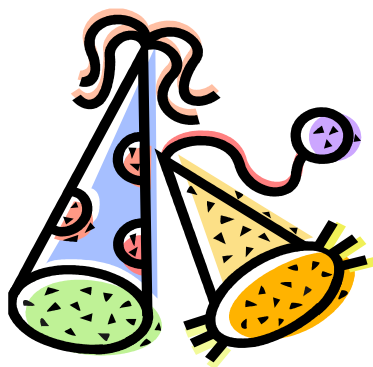

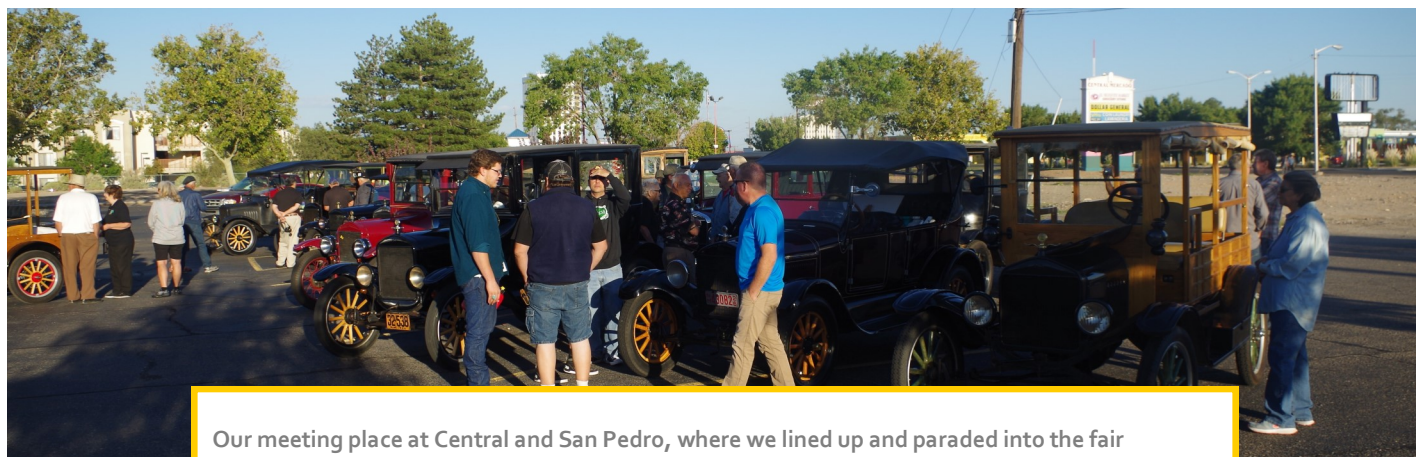

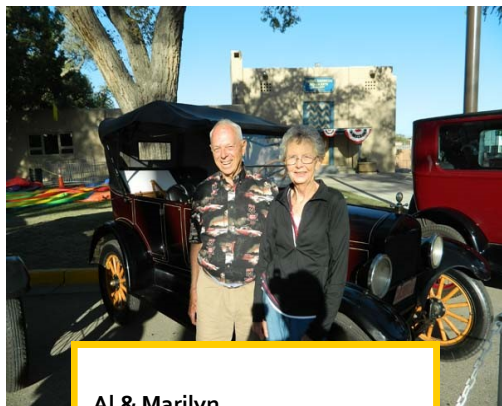

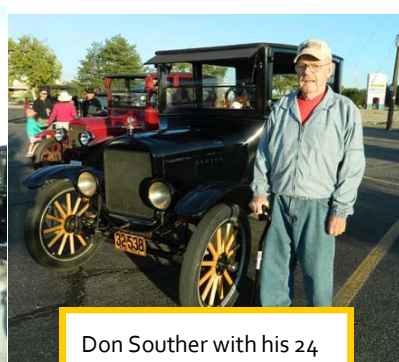

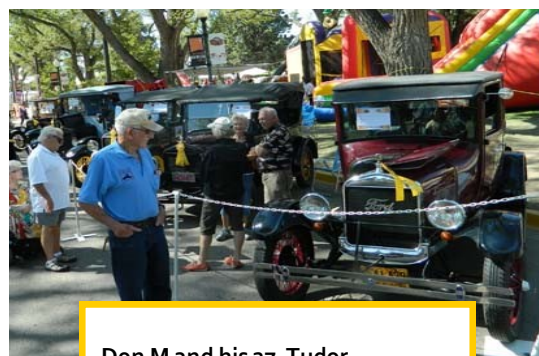

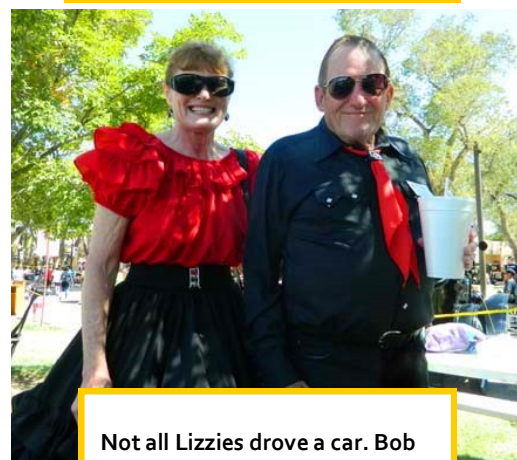

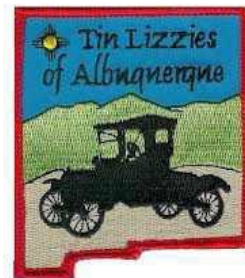

September 22, 2016

The minutes of the last meeting were corrected. Art Gebeau's name was misspelled in the previous month's minutes

Vice President Vaughn Rockefeller showed raffle items for this evening's drawing.

Marilyn Duncan reported income from the National Tour Raffle, membership dues, door magnet sales, and the August Raffle. Door magnets are still available to purchase.

The September meeting was a week early and focused on information about and job assignments for the Swap Meet to be held September 23, 24 and 25 in Los Lunas. Their Facebook page has information on many stolen vehicles and it and e-mails to members are credited with recovery of several vehicles.

Linda Riel, new hospitality chairman, reported that cards were sent to Irene Sena. Clarence is home recovering and Irene Navarre is now 99, doing well, and misses the club members. Robbi needs information for the Newsletter no later than Saturday evening. Historian Marilyn Duncan reports no news as Historian. Linda Riel reminded members to let her know if they wish to be notified of meetings via phone.

Mark Wing reported that he has added the State Fair and two work parties to our website. There were 1040 unique visitors to the web site in the last 30 days.

Quartermaster Larry Azevedo reports all parts and supplies are in stock. All borrowed parts and tools have been returned. All other committees reported no changes.

The T'n Vittles breakfast on September 10 was hosted by Vernon and Jo Ann Armstrong at Henrietta's in Los Lunas. There were 2 cars present and about 23 members.

Larry Azevedo reported a lot of projects have been completed at the last two work parties.

Susan Dominguez reported that refunds have been made to all Tour attendees to cover the funds over collected from participants. Two of those receiving refunds returned them to the club as donations, saying that they felt the tour was a good value and well worth the initial budgeted cost.

The State Fair exhibit organized by Vaughn Rockefeller was a success with 22 Model T's on exhibit. The goal for future years is to have more T's than A's.

Sharon Dominguez is arranging a Christmas Dinner to be held at the Cooperage Restaurant, Lomas and Louisiana, on December 11 at 2:00 pm. Motion was made, seconded, discussed and approved that the cost would be \$10.00 for each attendee with the club picking up any additional cost after a menu has been arranged. Members are invited to bring an unwrapped toy to the event that will be given to the Toys for Tots organization for distribution at Christmas.

Betty Householder is organizing a display of our cars at the Albuquerque International Balloon Fiesta on October 2. Parking and gate passes were given to those planning to attend. Paul Duncan invited members to use his fenced property near the Balloon Fiesta site before and after the show. Betty Householder also said that our cars could be placed at the Fiesta on Saturday afternoon.

The Corrales light parade will be held December 3, 2016. Parade participants can arrive at the Azevedo residence about 4:00 pm and proceed to the parade route at 5:30. Attendees should bring a snack to enjoy

afterward at the Azevedo residence.

Larry Azevedo will host a work party on October 8 following the T'n Vittles breakfast and the trip to the J & R Museum. Breakfast and the Museum tour are sponsored by Donna and Bill Hansen.

Members were reminded that nominations for club officers are due next month. Our Board members are working to get a list of nominees together to present at the November meeting.

Members enjoyed cookies, ice cream and drinks for meeting refreshments, provided by the O'Briens, Guanas, and Don Mitchell.

Mary Ann O'Brien reported on their delivery of a Model T engine to the Model T Museum for an individual living near there. Despite damage to their new RV and a balky lift, delivery was made. They enjoyed the Museum and complemented the quality of the Museum. Bob Hawk also reported his wonderful experience when he and Liz recently visited the Museum.

October refreshments will be provided by Vern Harvey, Bob Hawk and Liz Scott.

Mike Householder invited members to participate with cars and attendance at the St. Felix Pantry fundraiser to be held October 23, 2016, in the St. Pius High School Gym. Attendees driving T's will be admitted free and others will pay \$15.00. Members are invited to participate in the silent auction of donated items.

Raffle winners were Stan Guana, Susan Dominguez, and Paul Duncan.

The meeting was adjourned.

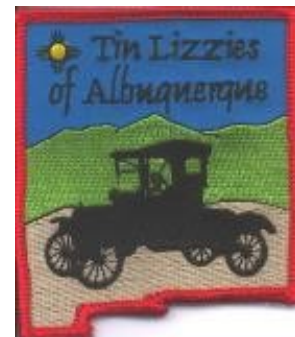
