Join us on May 12 for a leisurely drive along the original route of the Camino Real and Pre-1937 US 66 to the Village of Los Lunas for 11:00AM brunch at Teofilo's Restaurante. After brunch, we will visit a very nice private car collection at the Mid-Valley Air Park. Then we will cross the Rio Grande and drive around El Cerro de Tomé (Tomé Hill), a significant geological formation, landmark and cultural site on the Camino Real. We will stop at the Puerta del Sol Sculpture, which is located in a small park at the base of the hill. This large sculpture by renowned artist Armando Alvarez honors the history of El Camino Real travelers and frames a unique perspective of the trail followed by religious pilgrims and recreational hikers alike.

On the way back to Albuquerque, we will pass through the historic agricultural communities of Valencia, Peralta and Bosque Farms on NM 47. Then will detour briefly through Isleta Pueblo on the early route which took east-west travelers through the Plaza and past historic San Augustine Church. After a brief stop on the plaza, we will head back home.

For those who would like to travel as a group, please gather in the parking lot of the National Hispanic Cultural Center at 10:00AM. We will depart for Los Lunas at 10:15AM. At the restaurant, please park in the gravel lot on the west side of the building. There we will have space reserved for the traditional T lineup. Driving directions for the post-brunch tour will be provided at the restaurant.
